Nara Mahoroba Ink

Nara was the first capital city of Japan and expressed as the splendid land, namely "Mahoroba" in Man-yo-syu (万葉集); the oldest collection of Japanese poetries from the 8th century. "Awo Ni Yoshi" is an old poetic epithet in Man-yo-syu to portray Nara as the flourishing country. We wanted to release the product that is emblematic of Nara, whose history'd inspired us. The concept is creating your original color with the three primary colors.

④ Horyuji Temple Persimmon Orange

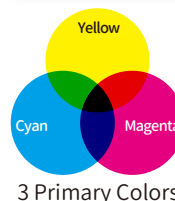

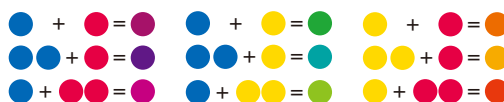
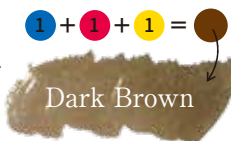

Point

Uncountably different colors can be created, blending previously mixed Nara Mahoroba Ink.



Mixture makes brightness lower, very close to black. With the same amount of them, you can find dark brown. Because this ink is water dye, you can use water to dilute and enjoy color variations. This ink kit doesn't require special transparent liquid. Ink is so deep that 1-2 drops would be enough. Please mix ink little by little. By diluting ink with water, the colors can become pale.



Mixed colors can be used with a glass pen, brush, dip pen "Water Paint Brush" and "Empty Marker".
